

Re-marketed N-95 respirators information

Local and Regional Partners:

This website will be very useful as SNS masks are received and we are not sure as to what brand they may be sending.

OPHP continues to receive inquiries regarding the possibility of identical models of N-95 masks being marketed by multiple suppliers. If these are found, it would eliminate the need for extensive fit testing of staff.

The following message was supplied to the states by the CDC DSNS to help address this issue.

If you feel you have N-95 masks that are identical, the following information may assist you.

How can I determine if a specific N95 respirator has been re-marketed by a different company under another model number?

In some cases, the same product is marketed by separate companies under different model numbers. You can determine if N95 respirators are re-marketed under other companies and associated model numbers by visiting http://www.cdc.gov/niosh/npptl/topics/respirators/disp_part/default.html.

Using the product approval information from this site, you can then contact OSHA to determine if the fit characteristics of your current respirator are acceptable for the re-marketed product.
